- Work with pupils on therapy or care programme, designed and supervised by a therapist/care professional
- Support the development/ oversee the work of other support staff
- Day to day allocation of work to other staff, requiring occasional supervisory responsibility
- Establish and maintain relationships with families, carers and other adults e.g. speech therapists
