Key Duties / Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will have responsibility for –

- Providing learning activities for individuals and groups of pupils under the professional direction and supervision of a qualified teacher, differentiating and adapting learning programmes to suit the needs of allocated pupils with SEN
- Planning and evaluating specialist learning activities with the teacher, writing reports and records as required
- Working with pupils on therapy or care programme, designed and supervised by a therapist/care professional
- Supporting the development/ overseeing the work of other support staff
- Day to day allocation of work to other staff, requiring occasional supervisory responsibility
- Establishing and maintaining relationships with families, carers and other adults e.g. speech therapists
